**Driving Directions**

From the Hartford Area: Follow Interstate 84 East to exit #68. Turn right at end of exit onto Route 195 South, following signs to Storrs and the University of Connecticut, approximately 6 miles. Continue on Route 195 through the campus area, passing a small lake (Mirror Lake) on the right. At light past lake, turn right onto Mansfield Rd.

From Massachusetts via Route 84: Follow Interstate 84 West to exit #68. Turn left onto Route 195 South, following signs to Storrs and the University of Connecticut, approximately 6 miles. Continue on Route 195 through the campus area, passing a small lake (Mirror Lake) on the right. At light past lake, turn right onto Mansfield Rd.

**Music Building**

The Music Building is located at 1295 Storrs Rd. (Route 195), between Mansfield Rd. and Bolton Rd. (just south of letter A on map). Landmark is green cylinder which houses Music & Dramatic Arts Library and lobby entrance to building. University Lot 1 (see map) is located behind Music Building and Nathan Hill Inn is up hill behind Lot 1.

**Parking**

Parking in university parking lots is restricted during business hours (8:30-5), M-F. Violators will be ticketed. All university visitors are welcome at South and North Parking Garages. For South Garage, take second left off of Mansfield Rd. onto Gilbert Rd. Follow Gilbert Rd. to end and turn right onto Hillside Rd. Turn left onto Stadium Rd. (between Coop and Gampel Pavilion) to enter garage. If South Garage is full, return to intersection of Stadium Rd. and Hillside Rd., turn left onto Hillside Rd. and continue to North Garage.

Patrons of the Nathan Hale Inn may park behind the inn by using a key card. The address of the Nathan Hall Inn is 855 Bolton Rd., but access is from Gilbert Rd. Take second left from Mansfield Rd. onto Gilbert Rd. Take second left (unmarked) off of Gilbert Rd. Nathan Hale Inn is ahead, slightly to the left. For walking access to Music Building, take stairs down to Lot 1 and proceed across lot toward green cylinder (Music & Dramatic Arts Library).

Lot 1 is unrestricted after 5 p.m. on Friday and all day Saturday. From Mansfield Rd., take first left onto Coventry Rd. Make slight right and slight left to enter parking lot. Parking meters are located at entrance to Mansfield Rd. and at other areas on campus.
